TRAINING LOCAL WORKSHOPS IN THE GUIDELINES CONTENTS



The Libertec Project continues its scaffolding, currently immersed in phase 3 of its development. Within this phase, different local training workshops have been carried out in the different partner countries.

The Pinolivo Early Childhood Education Center in Marbella (Málaga-Spain) was the place chosen by teachers M^a Gracia Romero García (School director/Teacher), Alberto Cubero Serrano (School secretary/Teacher), M^a Dolores Latorre Peña (Coordinator strategic plan for gender equality in education/Teacher) and Gemma López Grau (Second cycle coordinator 3-6 years/Teacher) to teach local workshops during the month of October and expand the contents of the GUIDELINES among the professionals who They work at their school, all as a preparatory activity for the field test that will be carried out as the final point of this phase of the project.



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LOCAL WORKSHOP IN CEI PINOLIVO

These local workshops in Malaga were held in 3 sessions, each attended by twelve teachers from the aforementioned Pinolivo center. The sessions held had the objective of presenting and explaining to the teachers the guidelines developed, so that they are trained to put into practice the methodological indications of the GUIDELINES to digitize the pedagogical documentation. The teachers/educators participating in these workshops provided very positive feedback on the contents proposed by the Guidelines on digitalized pedagogical documentation as a tool to show and make visible the teaching and learning processes that take place every day at school.
