



THE AJEJD PORTUGUESE PARTNER MULTIPLIER EVENT PROGRAM (ME)

The ME organized on the 25th may 2024, by AJEJD partner, was held in Lisbon /Belas, Portugal. The event occurred from 9h30 to 12h30 – 3 hours – with the following program:

- Opening session and LIBERTEC project presentation (António Ponces de Carvalho)
• LIBERTEC Guidelines dissemination (Jaime Santos)
• Digital Resources for work and play (Jaime Santos, André Carvalho, Carolina Pereira)
➢ Workshops: 1. Apps for the organization of institutions
2. Apps for pedagogical organization
3. Apps to support learning.

The invited persons were João Teixeira, kasapt.org NGO Coordinator and Nuno Gomes, growthappy.com CEO – ECEC software.

REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPANTS

There were two possible kinds of presence.

- a) Participants registered in virtual means (Zoom Platform) were 73 and 65 validated. From this group there were teachers from 20 different schools and from 17 cities all over the country.
b) Participants in physical presence were 109. From these, 93 were participants that didn't work with the LIBERTEC Guidelines nor with recommended software. The 109 participants came from 11 schools placed at the Lisbon District.

MATERIALS

The Guidelines, DigCompEdu reference, software advice and other distributed documents were in digital format and, till the end of this project, can be accessed in https://t.ly/o0H_d. This access address was provided in written form on all the 174 certificates distributed to participants.

CONCLUSION

To accomplish the LIBERTEC validation criteria, the Multiplier Event held in Portugal by the AJEJD partner, had 93 new participants in physical presence, 65 in virtual means.

Considering all the registries this Event had 174 participants and they came from 31 schools or educational services.
